

- 1. Name Neutrophil
 - Granular
 - Function first to arrive at infection site, seen in bacterial infections
- 2. Name Red blood cell
 - Granular or Agranular
 - Function.
- 3. Name Lymphocyte
 - Agraniular

Function- smallest WBCs, large spherical nucleus surrounded by thin rim of cytoplasm, T-cells (attack pathogens, tumor cells) and B-cells (produce antibodies)
