- Foundations of Industrialization
 - Eventually, cheap textile production depended on the steam engine – invented by Scottish engineer James Watt in 1765.
 - In 1815, George Stephenson successfully tested the first steam locomotive.
 - Eventually (by the mid 1850s) the steam engine was used to power ocean liners.
 - Therefore, the steam engine, originally used in textile mills, transformed the transportation industry as well, making it much cheaper for both people and goods to travel from place to place.

When one considers different perspectives, America's uniqueness recedes in importance. American culture was a variant of a wider Western culture. The American economy was an extension of Western capitalism, whether agrarian, commercial, or industrial. American society was a Western society with racial castes and multi-ethnic additions to the population. American government functioned like other Western governments, even with innovative forms: Republican, then democratic. The American past is thus seen to be far less distinctive than previous syntheses have assumed.
