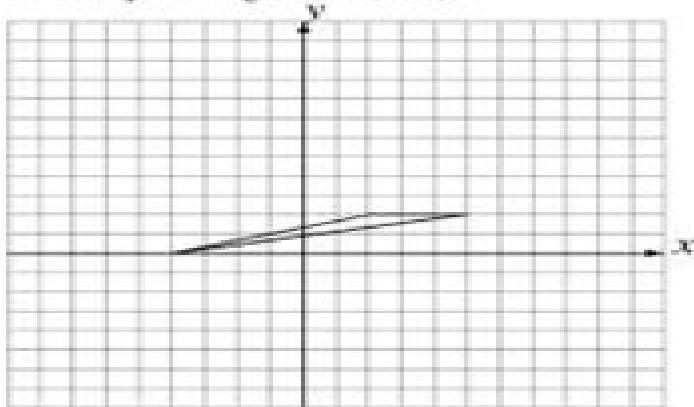


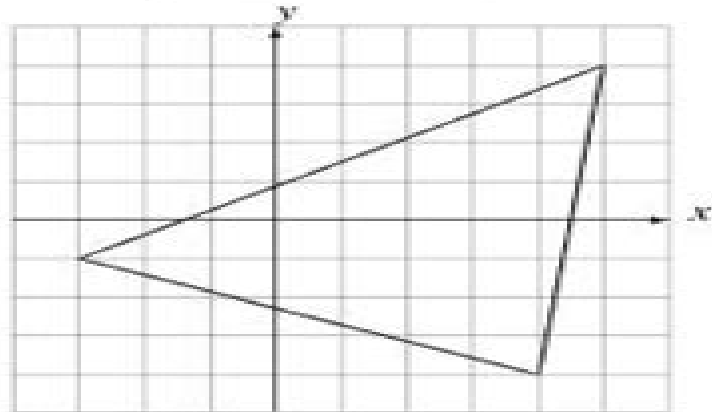

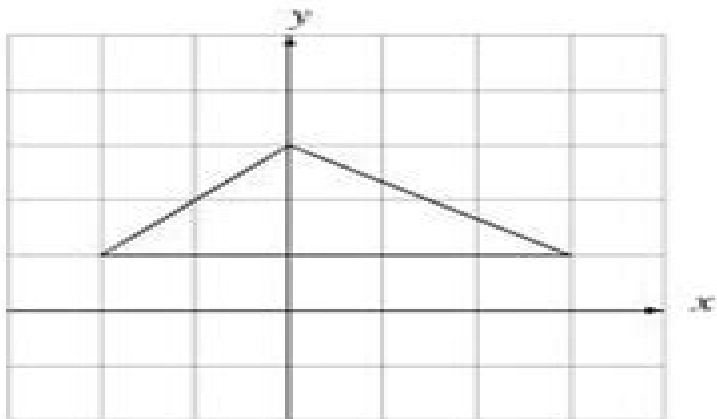

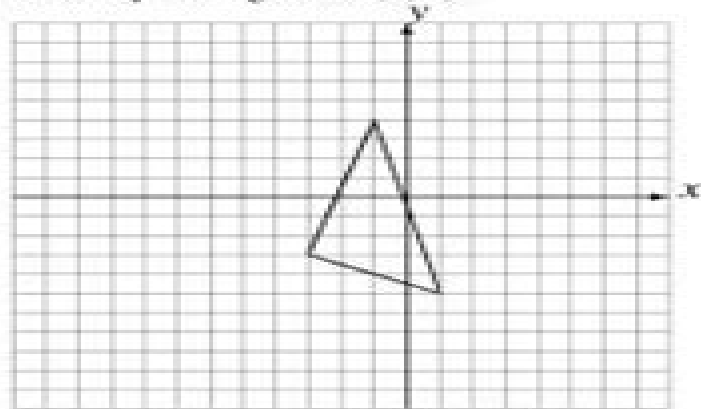
Dilate by $\frac{3}{4}$ using center $(0, 0)$.
