It is commonly said that death is life's only promise—which might explain why the argument about how it should come to pass, in the terminally ill, especially, is such a hot topic. Fear of hospitals would become ridiculous. The final argument against active euthanasia is that doctors should not have to kill. In 1961, Percy Bridgman committed suicide rather than fight cancer. In his suicide note, he wrote, "It is not decent for Society to make a man do this to himself" (Suicidology Online.) The logical question to this statement would be, "Then who is it decent for Society to make 'do this'? Surely not doctors! The professi
