 - Adenine (A) and Thymine (T)
 - Cytosine (C) and Guanine (G)
 Each set of three consecutive

bases is a code for a particular amino acid.

1.3. THREE PROCESSES OF ACCESSING GENETIC INFORMATION

 DNA replication- (1) chains of double helix untwist and separate.

 -(2) each half builds a new partner chain from free DNA bases.

- Transcription- (3) copies the sequence of one strand of DNA molecule into mRNA.
- Translation- (4) each 3 RNA bases in a row attract another type of RNA that functions as a connector, bringing in a particular amino acid.

-(5) Amino aids align and link to form protein.

1.2 THE HUMAN GENOME

- 20,325 protein- encoding genescomprise the exome.
 - Accounts: 1.5 percent of human genome, 85 percent of known genetic diseases
- Alleles ("gene variants")-same protein- encoding genes may variate in DNA base sequence from person to person that is passed to the next generation.
- Mutation (" changed gene")
 -alteration or change in genes, causing a disease.

1.3. MUTATION DISEASES

 - Change of a "C" to "T" inserts amino acid rather than the amino acid glycine which results to protein becoming abnormal
