

THE DISAPPEARANCE OF AMELIA EARHART

The mystery of what happened to female aviator Amelia Earhart has intrigued people around the world for decades.

She was going to be the first woman to pilot an aircraft around the world. Instead, she disappeared during her flight in 1937. There are several theories about what may have happened to her, but to this day, nothing has been confirmed.

Who was Amelia Earhart?

Amelia Earhart was born on July 24, 1897 in Atchison, Kansas. She didn't conform to the gender roles of the time. She took an auto repair class and played basketball. Those were not common things for girls to do at the time.

As a young adult in 1918, Earhart lived in Toronto and worked as a nurse's aide. She would spend her time watching the Royal Flying Corps at a nearby field and she got to know a lot of wounded pilots.

When she was 23, Earhart moved to Los Angeles. Shortly after she arrived in 1920, she flew as a passenger in a plane. Earhart wanted more though, and she took her first flying lesson in January 1921. She was a natural aviator.

When she was 24, Earhart bought her first plane with money she borrowed from her family. It was a used yellow Kinner Airster with 2 seats. She called it "The Canary."

Her first flight did not go as planned. The engine lost power, the plane hit trees and then crashed to the ground.

Earhart reportedly climbed out of the plane, checked to make sure the instructor was all right, and then went back to the cockpit to put on makeup just in case any reporters showed up.

The plane was fixed, and in December 1921, Earhart got her pilot's licence in the United States.

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
