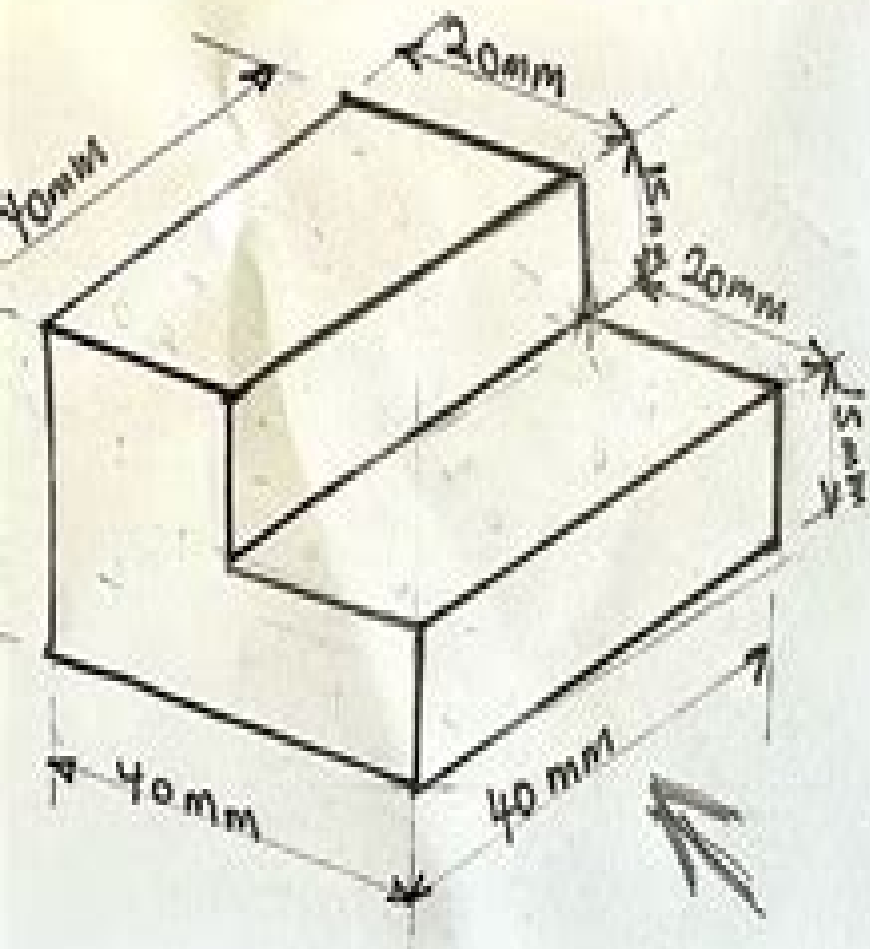


Orthographic Projection From Isometric
