By claiming that it does not necessarily belong to any one mind in particular is inferring then that the self is not in fact a property. Then how can it be said to exist? According to Locke the old man is the same as the middle aged one, and the middle aged is the same as the child. Yet there is no continuity of consciousness between the three, any break in memory would render them a 'non-person' if we follow Locke's argument-clearly it is logically inconsistent. David Hume's 'bundle theory' of the self seems to me rather more logically coherent. He claimed that humans tend to think of themselves as the same person as they were, say, 10 years ago; that we believed that although one had evolved over the period in a number of ways that the self had endured.

According to Hume however, this was a mistake, and when examined empirically no more than a practical habit: "I never can catch myself at any time without a perception, and never observe anything but the perception" (TI, vi, p. 251). It is clear, posits Hume, our thoughts and perceptions flow from one idea to the next; so we encounter a 'bundle', or grouping, of perceptions throughout our life but no actual continuous and enduring underlying self- or "I" -as a 'unity of consciousness'.

While there is a stability of perceptions over the short term, and some loose association of experiences, there is no overarching continuity of "I" in reality. Hume agrees that we extend over time in actions, we begin a job and finish it some time later, and that our desires also extend in some sort of continuity over time. Furthermore our physical bodies endure reasonably consistently; we age gradually. This according to Hume is what ultimately defines our sense of personal identity. While Hume's theory of the self is attractive in my view, if anything it doesn't go far
