Exemplar Question:

Explain why US involvement in Vietnam increased in the years 1963-65. (12 marks)

You may use the following in your answer:

- US advisors
- The Gulf of Tonkin Resolution

Advices

- This type of question on the GCSE exam paper is asking you to explain a few reasons why an event happened or took place.
- The time that you should take to complete this question in the exam is roughly 15 minutes.
- As part of the exam question you are provided with two pieces of information that may help you
 with the answer.
- If you choose not to use the two bullet points to create paragraphs you will not have marks taken
 off you so long as you provide two other information points to support your answer.
- If you do use the two information points in your answer you WILL need to include a new key point
 of your own.
- If you wish to achieve a higher score out of 12 for this question then you need to include your own information.
- In the answer booklet provided by Edexcel you will have 2 sides of A4 lined paper to answer the
 question.
- It is not compulsory for you to use both sides of A4 but you need to write at least 3 paragraphs to
 give you the best chance of getting the highest mark.

TOP TIPS:

- Make sure that you read the question. This one is asking you to explain WHY something happened?
- If it is worth 12 marks then you need to provide 3 clear reasons for WHY the USA became more involved in the Vietnam War between 1963-1965.
- Check the dates do not refer to events after 1965.
- You need some analysis.
- Your answer needs to make sense.

You need specific accurate information in your answer (you don't get marks for guessing):

- Accurate dates (when an event happens don't guess!)
- Accurate names (presidents, leaders, names of boats, battles and equipment)
- Accurate statistics (how many soldiers arrive in Vietnam, how much did USA involvement increase, what amount of money was spent, how many people died).
