

associated with oversaturated signalized intersections Several recommendations for future research in the area of traffic management techniques were developed Fundamentally it is recommended that additional research be conducted on the effectiveness of alternative traffic management techniques For neighborhood traffic management techniques before and after data are needed to assess technique effectiveness in terms of volume reduction speed reduction and crash reduction For corridor traffic management further research efforts are necessary to verify the accuracy of the cut through traffic prediction model developed for this research Design, Operation, and Safety of At-grade Crossings of Exclusive Busways Kimberly A.
