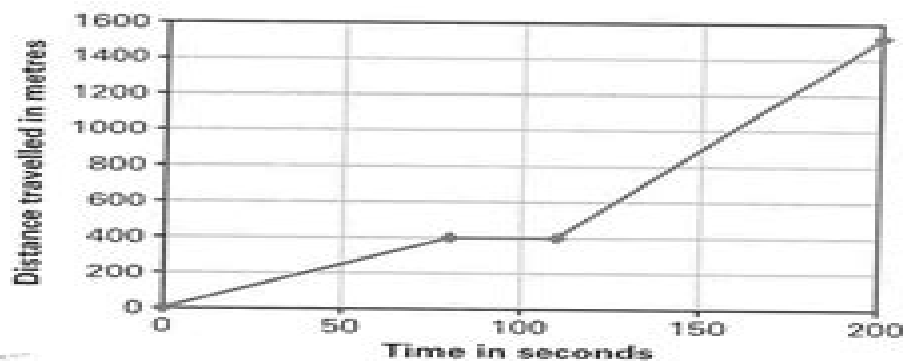


11. William gets on a bus and makes a journey of 1500 metres.
