actual projected data and or 2 as a ratio or quotient of its actual projected and budgeted data called performance index PI A PI value equals to 1 indicates that the evaluated task has been executed or is expected to be executed as it was foreseen in the estimate budget or in the planning on target performance A PI value smaller than 1 except for the project value quantity of works income profit loss and others not expended items indicates that the task has been executed or is expected to be executed with a performance better than what was foreseen in the estimate budget or in the planning good performance A PI value greater than 1 except for the items listed above indicates a poor performance of the task The performance indexes selected for the project control could be computed by means of a computer program The input data required for this program will be fed by the site management and other units of the project organization.
