Diagnosis of salivary gland disorders K. Graamans, Hans Van den Akker, 1991-09-30 Historically disorders of salivary glands tend to be underdiagnosed and overtreated In the vast body of literature on this subject emphasis has usually been put on therapeutic modalities of various diseases of the salivary glands Whereas therapy and pathology have been treated in numerous thorough studies the patho physiology of the salivary glands has remained rather poorly understood Even less attention has been given to the diagnostic methods Until a few decades ago diagnosis consisted mainly of a clinical examination which included the patient's history inspection and palpation These methods remain crucial but a variety of new diagnostic tools have appeared since then Their clinical value is still subject to controversy each method has its advocates and opponents The indications for enrolling a patient at a given point in a series of diagnostic procedures are interpreted differently One of the most striking examples is the use of sialography This has become a classic diagnostic procedure Although sialography is still a useful method it has considerable disadvantages limitations and even contraindications In the major teaching hospitals residents still tend to consider sialography as a panacea for the majority of their diagnostic problems whereas the information provided is actually rather restricted Other modern methods such as CT and MRI have taken over the role of sialography to a certain extent This also applies to ultrasonography and scintigraphy Moreover microbiology sialometry sialochemistry cytology and histopathology may give superior information in certain cases

Bacterial Capsules Klaus Jann, Barbara Jann, 2012-12-06 Many bacteria such as certain *Neisseria* and *Haemophilus* or *Escherichia coli* are able to withstand the bactericidal activity of complement and phagocytes This bacterial self protection is brought about by encapsulation Bacterial capsules thus enable the pathogenic bacteria to survive in the host by counteraction or evasion of the nonspecific host defense in the early pre immune phase of an infection It is only in the late immune phase of the infection when specific anticapsular antibodies are formed and enforce the host's defense system that this protective action is overcome Encapsulated bacteria are then killed and eliminated Interestingly some capsules can not or only inefficiently be handled by the immune system The ensuing lack of antibody formation results in a prolonged susceptibility of the host to the pathogenic bacteria exhibiting such capsules It was found that bacterial capsules consist of acidic polysaccharides From this it followed that the role of the capsules in the interaction of encapsulated bacteria with the host may be due to the chemistry of the capsular polysaccharides This led to intensive studies of capsular polysaccharides in many laboratories Our increasing knowledge of the structural features of capsular polysaccharides prompted not only immunochemical studies analyzing the interactions of these polysaccharide antigens and characterizing the epitopes but also investigations into their biosynthesis These studies were complemented and supported by genetic analyses Today many interdisciplinary investigations of capsular polysaccharides are in progress Human Pharmacology Helmut Paul

Kuemmerle, Takeshi Shibuya, Jean-Paul Tillement, 1991 Pharmacology is the science of the action of drugs on the body and incorporates all aspects from conception synthesis and effects of drugs to the eventual use in humans In the initial stages of conception animal models and cellular models in vitro are utilized to form a hypothesis about the benefits of a drug before clinical trials This next stage of clinical pharmacology is pivotal as it will validate what was previously conjecture but the risks taken must be more limited because human beings are involved The most sophisticated methods of measurement and analysis are utilized at this stage to achieve maximum information with a minimal number of samples The intention of Human Pharmacology is to examine the state of the art techniques of analysis and measurement of drug concentration in an organism and of pharmacokinetic methods and their interpretation Firstly the work identifies the chemical species of the drug and its metabolites by analysis of biotransformations and sequential quantification of the active forms of the drug and or

Bacterial Aerosols Resulting from Spray Irrigation with Wastewater Howard T. Bausum, 1976 Air sampling equipment was selected and adapted for the study of bacterial aerosols generated through land application of treated wastewater by spray irrigation Preliminary data were obtained on bacteria present in treated and untreated domestic sewage at Army installations Data were also obtained on survival of enteric bacteria in laboratory aerosols generated from wastewater at various relative humidities A field study of 3 weeks duration was undertaken to measure aerosol dissemination of bacteria at a wastewater spray irrigation site at Ft Huachuca Az Aerosol densities for the total aerobic bacteria ranged up to 1630 cu m at sampling points nearest the aerosol source Confirmed coliform bacteria represented about 0.5 percent of the total and of those nearly half were *Klebsiella* Densities were greater under conditions of low wind atmospheric stability and darkness A mathematical model predicting downwind aerosol densities was developed based on the dispersion equation of Pasquill and took into account the parameters of the spray equipment used The model in conjunction with fluorescein tracer data was used in deriving an estimate of the fraction of wastewater entering the aerosol state
