own world Ultimately this book uses science fiction to highlight educational inequities in such wide ranging topics as standard English literary canons machine learning notions of academic dishonesty epistemicide inequitable school discipline and more More importantly however it provides a framework for moving forward giving current and future educators the critical knowledge and skills both to recognize pedagogical injustice and to create viable just and sustainable alternatives
