According to The Water Project, "water scarcity is either the lack of enough water (quantity) or lack of access to safe water (quality)" (The Water Project, para. 1). A shortage of clean water is an issue in many countries compounding poverty, causing sickness, and hindering the growth of essential infrastructure.

On the typical day when the municipal service doesn't deliver enough water, she dials the private water tanker on her cell phone, then waits for its arrival. In an average month, she gets only 13 gallons from the municipal pipes and 243 gallons from water tankers. (p. 425)
