Subcommittee on National Security, 2018 [Documenting Aftermath](#) Megan Finn, 2018-10-30 An examination of how changing public information infrastructures shaped people's experience of earthquakes in Northern California in 1868 1906 and 1989 When an earthquake happens in California today residents may look to the United States Geological Survey for online maps that show the quake's epicenter turn to Twitter for government bulletins and the latest news check Facebook for updates from friends and family and count on help from the Federal Emergency Management Agency FEMA One hundred and fifty years ago however FEMA and other government agencies did not exist and information came by telegraph and newspaper In *Documenting Aftermath* Megan Finn explores changing public information infrastructures and how they shaped people's experience of disaster examining postearthquake information and communication practices in three Northern California earthquakes the 1868 Hayward Fault earthquake the 1906 San Francisco earthquake and fire and the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake She then analyzes the institutions policies and technologies that shape today's postdisaster information landscape Finn argues that information orders complex constellations of institutions technologies and practices influence how we act in experience and document events What Finn terms event epistemologies constituted both by historical documents and by researchers who study them explain how information orders facilitate particular possibilities for knowledge After the 1868 earthquake the Chamber of Commerce telegraphed reassurances to out of state investors while local newspapers ran sensational earthquake narratives in 1906 families and institutions used innovative techniques for locating people and in 1989 government institutions and the media developed a symbiotic relationship in information dissemination Today government disaster response plans and new media platforms imagine different sources of informational authority yet work together shaping disaster narratives **The Legacy of Hurricane Mitch** Marisa O. Ensor, 2022-05-10 Around the world disaster vulnerability is on the rise The incidence and intensity of disasters have increased in recent decades with lives being shattered and resources being destroyed across broad geographic regions each year As it swept across the Honduran landscape the exceptional size power and duration of Hurricane Mitch abruptly and brutally altered the already diminished economic social and environmental conditions of the population In the aftermath of the disaster a group of seven socio environmental scientists set out to investigate the root causes of the heightened vulnerability that

characterized pre Mitch Honduras the impact of the catastrophe on the local society and the subsequent recovery efforts Edited by Marisa O Ensor this volume presents the findings of their investigation The Legacy of Hurricane Mitch offers a comprehensive analysis of the immediate and long term consequences of Hurricane Mitch in Honduras Based on longitudinal ethnographic fieldwork and environmental assessments this volume illustrates the importance of adopting an approach to disaster research and practice that places natural trigger events within their political cultural and socio economic contexts The contributors make a compelling case against post disaster recovery efforts that limit themselves to alleviating the symptoms rather than confronting the root causes of the vulnerability that prefigured the disaster

Powerless Diana Hernández, Jennifer Laird, 2025-04-08 Energy serves as the lifeblood of our daily experiences It permeates virtually every aspect of our existence facilitating nourishment safety and productivity When affordability threatens energy's availability a family's living situation can become untenable too cold too hot too dark and too often unhealthy and unsafe In *Powerless* sociologists Diana Hernández and Jennifer Laird reveal the hidden hardship of energy insecurity the inability to adequately meet household energy needs Approximately one in ten households in the U S are energy insecure and four in ten are at risk for energy insecurity These statistics alone do not convey the acute pain of utility shutoffs or the relentless toll of chronic energy hardships marked by difficult choices and harsh living conditions Drawing on survey data and interviews with one hundred energy insecure individuals and families Hernández and Laird detail the experience of energy insecurity Individuals and families suffering from energy insecurity endure economic hardships such as difficulty paying utility bills utility debt and disconnection from utility services They also struggle with physical challenges such as poor housing conditions and poor or dysfunctional heating and cooling systems They are often forced to make difficult choices about what bills to pay These decisions are sometimes referred to as heat or eat choices as families cannot afford to pay for heating and food at the same time Energy insecure individuals and families employ a variety of strategies to keep energy costs down to avoid having to make these hard choices This includes deliberate underconsumption of energy enduring physical discomfort and using dangerous alternatives such as open flames ovens or space heaters to try to maintain a comfortable temperature in their home To be energy insecure is to suffer Despite the heavy toll of energy insecurity most people confront these difficulties behind closed doors believing it is a private matter Thus the enormous social crisis of energy insecurity goes unnoticed Hernández and Laird argue that household energy is a basic human right and detail policies and practices that would expand access to consistent safe clean and affordable energy Their proposals include improving the current energy safety net which is limited and often does not serve the most energy insecure due to stringent program requirements and administrative burdens They also suggest redesigning rates to accommodate income promoting enrollment and expansion of discount programs reforming utility disconnection policies improving energy literacy and ensuring an equitable shift to renewable energy resources *Powerless* creates a comprehensive picture of the complex social and environmental issue of energy insecurity and shows how energy equity is not just an aspiration but an achievable reality

Pilot study on the experiences of hurricane shelter evacuees Laura DiGrande, Lisa Carley-Baxter, Christine Bevc, Suzanne Triplett, Craig William, Lewis-Owen, Jessica Williams, 2019-09-11 Community members who evacuate to shelters may represent the most socially and economically vulnerable group within a hurricane's affected geographic area Disaster research has established associations between socioeconomic conditions and adverse effects but data are overwhelmingly collected retrospectively on large populations and lack further explication As Hurricane Florence approached North Carolina in September 2018 RTI

International developed a pilot survey for American Red Cross evacuation shelter clients Two instruments an interviewer led paper questionnaire and a short message service SMS text questionnaire were tested A total of 200 evacuees completed the paper survey but only 34 participated in the SMS text portion of the study Data confirmed that the sample represented very marginalized coastline residents 60 percent were unemployed 70 percent had no family or friends to stay with during evacuation 65 percent could not afford to evacuate to another location 36 percent needed medicine medical care and 11 percent were homeless Although 19 percent of participants had a history of evacuating for prior hurricanes disasters and 14 percent had previously utilized shelters we observed few associations between previous experiences and current evacuation resources behaviors or opinions about safety This study demonstrates that for vulnerable populations exposed to storms of increasing intensity and frequency traditional survey research methods are best employed to learn about their experiences and needs

Mi María: Surviving the Storm Ricia Anne Chansky, Marci Denesiuk, 2021-09-04 When Hurricane Mar a made landfall in Puerto Rico in September 2017 it left no part of the archipelago unscathed The hurricane triggered floods and mudslides washed out roads destroyed tens of thousands of homes farms and businesses caused the largest blackout in US history knocked out communications led to widespread food drinking water and gasoline shortages and caused thousands of deaths The seventeen oral histories collected in Mi Mar a Surviving the Storm share stories of surviving the storm and its long aftermath as people waited for relief and aid that rarely arrived Zaira and her husband floated on a patched air mattress for sixteen hours while floodwaters rose around them The road washed out in front of Emmanuel as he desperately tried to drive his pregnant wife who had begun labor to the hospital Luis and his father anxiously counted the days that the dialysis clinic remained closed and lifesaving treatment was unavailable while Miliana s mother was sent home from the hospital undiagnosed only to fall critically ill in her own home Weaving together long form oral histories and shorter testimonios the book offers a multivocal peoples history of disaster that fosters a greater understanding of the failures of governmental disaster response and the correlating perseverance of the people impacted by these failures highlighting the colonial relationship between Puerto Rico and the United States Ultimately the ways in which these oral histories demonstrate the strength of community response to disaster in Puerto Rico are pertinent to other parts of the world that are being impacted by our current climate emergency
