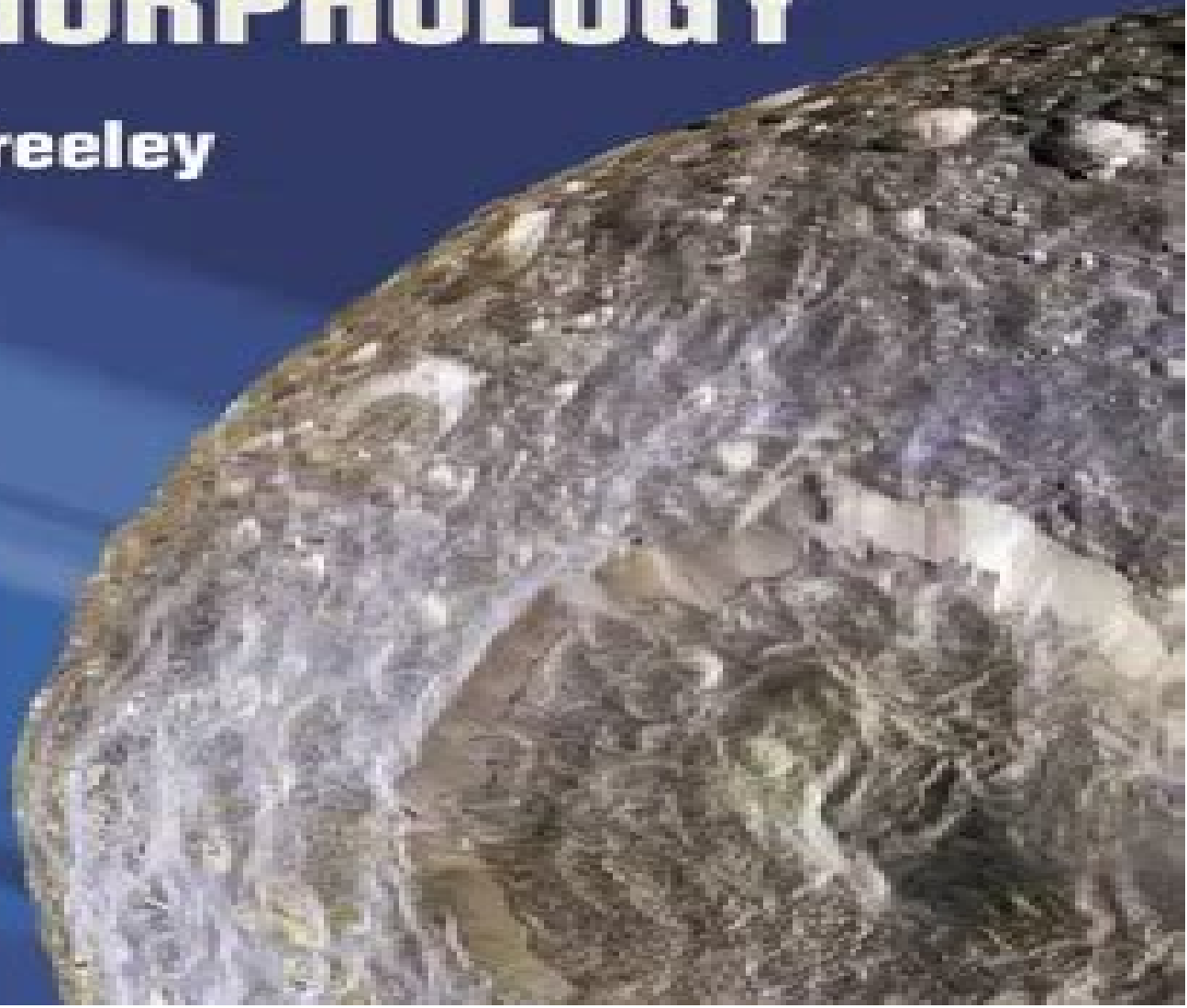

Star War that occurred 800 000 years ago He reveals parallels between this story and ancient Sumerian stories of the Anunnaki occupation of Earth and Mars as documented by Zecharia Sitchin Haas also shows how there is a direct correlation between the ruins on Mars and the art and architecture of Mesoamerican cultures providing clear evidence of a long disappeared Martian civilization that we are only now rediscovering
