Christmas tree worms Opheliida Capitellida including five families of truly worm like annelids without appendages represents the contrary Their members burrow in soft bottom substrates and may be classified as non selective deposit feeders. Molecular phylogenetic analyses have shown that Echiura or spoon worms formerly regarded to represent a separate phylum are members of this group Last not least Hrabeiellidae is one out of only two families of oligochaete like terrestrial polychaetes and for this reason received strong scientific interest
