The entire education system is based on Turkishness Non Turkish groups are either not referred to or referred in a negative way says Kaya Education system has played a significant role in deepening conflict in society The positive representation of other groups in the education system would contribute to social peace and harmony In order to resolve the many problems in the education system that the current approach causes the overall aim of government education policy should be cleared of ideological references and the protection of children's best interests and the right to education in line with international standards should be considered its
