The Ancient Greece civilization dominated much of the Mediterranean. This culture formed the foundation of much of the Western culture of today.

An acropolis is a group of temples. The know Acropolis is the one in Athens that sits on a high, rocky hill. This Acropolis was constructed during the 5th century BC. It sits around 492 feet above sea level, making it a great place for the Greeks to defend themselves from during a war.



Many important temples were located on the Acropolis, including the Parthenon, the Temple of Athena, and the Temple of Nike.



The Discobolus of Myron is a marble sculpture of a male athlete throwing a discus. It was created by the ancient Greek sculptor, Myron, around 460 BC. It is one of the most famous sculptures created by him that still exist.

The discus throw was invented around 708 BC in Ancient Greece. It was one of the sports that were part of the ancient Olympic Games.

The First Olympic Games were held in 776 BCE. They were originally part of a religious festival that was held to honor Zeus. These games were held once every four years in August.

Starting with only short foot races, many other events were added over time. Women were not allowed to participate.

The Ancient Olympic Games ended in 393 AD. The modern Olympics started in 1896.



Greek ships were long ships that were run by sails or oarsmen. Some of these wooden ships were covered in brass to make them strong enough to be used in battle.

The Greeks were farmers who ate the food that they grew. The most common foods were asparagus, fennel, cucumbers, chickpeas, celery and fruits and vegetables. Honey was quite an important food in their diet.

The most important food was the

olive.

They crushed the olives to make oil which was used in lamps, beauty products and more.



The Greeks made and dyed their own

clothing.

They wore simple clothing which helped keep them cool during the hot summers.

The women wore a tunic known as a peplos. It was a full-length garment that was draped and pinned at the shoulder. A long, full garment known as a chiton was worn over the peplos.



The Greeks made coins mostly using silver, though they sometimes used gold, electrum, copper alloy and bronze. The metals were melted and then poured into molds.

One of the most famous designs of all is the owl of Athena. It appears on the silver tetradrachm coins of Athens. Athena was the patron of the city and appeared on the reverse side of the coin. It was the largest coin of its time.



Pottery

was an important part in the lives of the Greeks.



The laurel wreath was a symbol of Apollo. It was believed to have spiritual and physical cleansing abilities. The Ancient Greeks awarded laurel wreaths to the victors of the Olympic Games.



These wreaths were originally made from the bay laurel limbs and leaves. They were interwoven and shaped into a circle or horseshoe shape.

The Trojan horse is a huge wooden horse that was constructed by the Greeks. They used it to gain entrance into Troy during the Trojan War. The Greeks pretended to leave the war, leaving the horse for the Trojans. Believing it was a peace offering, the Trojans dragged the horse inside their city. While the Trojans slept, the Greeks that were hiding inside the horse came out, killed the Trojans, and opened the city for the Greeks. This allowed the Greeks to win the war.
