Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God; and whatever we ask, we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. And this is his love: that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and keep his commandments, just as he has commanded us. Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God is in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us."
