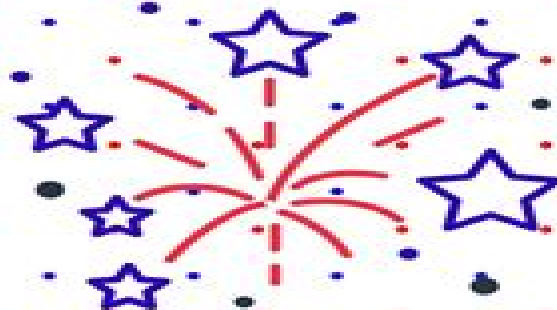

*Inventing the Working Parent* Sarah E.
