hands of the O'Donnells Columba's own clan who treasured it as their most precious possession. It was called the Cathach or Battler and if borne into battle by one of pure heart and of clean hands was believed to ensure them the victory over their enemies. It is the least ornamental of the three and bears traces of the haste with which it was executed.
