

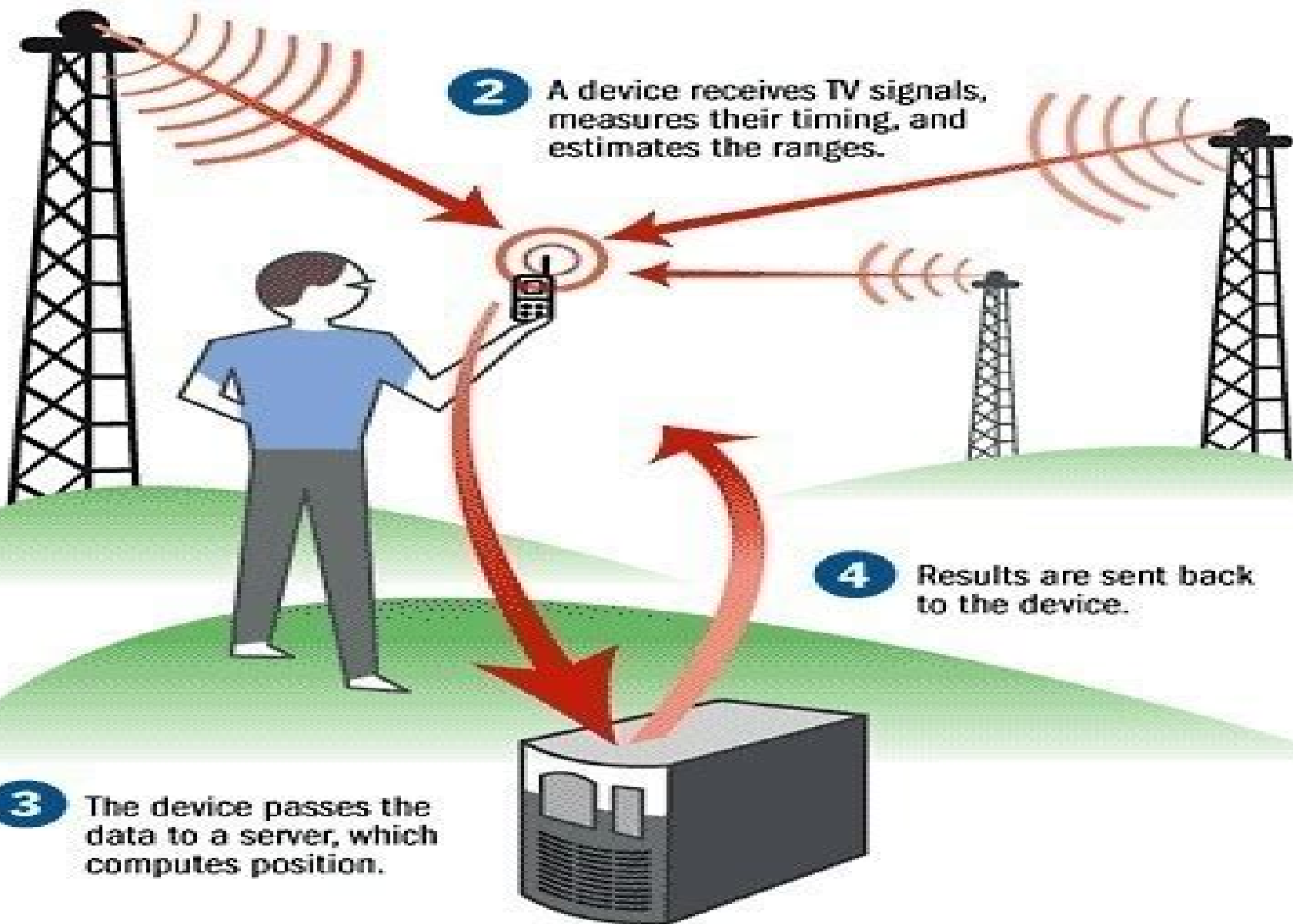
How TV-based positioning works
