14.1 Whole-Genome Sequencing

• How Do Complete Genome Sequences?

• Shotgun Sequencing

- Shotgun sequencing is genome is broken up into a set of overlapping fragments that are small enough to be sequenced individually.
- See next week's Figure 17.11
- The original strategy consisted of shuffling & generating lots of tiny small fragments, sequencing each fragment and then joining the sequences back together in the correct order

• The Impact of New Generation Sequencing

- Advances in DNA Sequencing can be sequenced individually to save up to 10% sequencing cost/frag. But downside is that they produce sequenced reads of only about 100-200 nucleotides
- Reads lengths are too short
- Second generation project sequencing the first human genome sequence

• Bioinformatics

- Bioinformatics is how that raw data/mathematics, computer science and biology is an effort to manage and analyze sequence data
- Bioinformatics have been able to make significant advances

• Which Genomes are Being Sequenced and Why?

• First genome to be sequenced from an organism was a bacterium (Bacillus) in the human upper respiratory tract

• Value of the organisms selected for whole genome sequencing have increasing biological properties, represent a particular branch of the information on evolutionary relationships or cause diseases

- Ex. Bacteria and viruses, bacterial, one and more, that there, human, human immune system, plant and animal related genomes

• Which Sequences Are Human?

• Genome project (the first human) had a sequencing a genome is to identify unknown human genes

• Identifying Genes in Bacterial and Animal Genomes

- Computer programs are used to scan the sequence of a genome to find structures and these programs identify each reading frame that is possible in the two strands of the DNA
- Computer programs take attention to any "open reads" stretches of sequence that lack an internal stop codon and are flanked by a stop codon and a start codon
- Computer programs look for open reading frames, sequences typical of proteins, including finding sites in other regulatory sites
- An open frame is significant amount of sequence with a known gene from another species, then it is very likely to be a gene
