If you do not complete this assignment, you may be removed from the class and/or your grade will begin with a serious deficit!

** Used book stores sometimes have copies of the book available for very low prices. Books may also be borrowed from a library or a friend, particularly if finances are a concern. <u>If borrowed</u> books are used for the assignment, write the annotations on sticky notes and stick the notes on the corresponding pages in the book.
