



Selector Switches

in order for this thermostat to control your system, the system type must be specified by the selector switches on the printed circuit, locand inside the thermostat. There is also a selector switch for your thoice of fighteenheit or Celsius temperature display.

Heating System Selector (HG - HE switch)


The factory position for this switch is in the "HG" position. Leave it in this position if you have a gas furnace or an oil burner. If you have an electric furnace, but to see whether the Heat and Fan come on as expected after installation. If the Fan op-eration is normal, leave it in the "HG" position. However, if you find your system cycling too fast or too slow, then the Span can be adjusted to modify the cycle time.

Low Battery Warning


