adult copepod

Copepods are the most common zooplankton worldwide. They are an integral part of
the food web as both predator and prey.





copepod nauplius

The nauplius is a common early larval stage of crustaceans. Some nauplii have spines while others do not.





polychaete worm larvae These organisms are the marine relative of earthworms. The larvae are found in the plankton. The adult form, seen in the invertebrate lab, is benthic.



barnacle nauplius Barnacle nauplii are distinguished from crab larvae by the "spikes" on their heads. This stage comes before the cypris stage.



cypris larva
The cypris is the final
larval stage of a barnacle. It must find a suitable attachment site to
become an adult.





adult Oikopleura sp.

This organism is actually an adult tunicate that retains its notochord and tail. The tall beats back and forth rapidly to create a current that brings food near the mouth.



tunicate (sea squirt) larva
This "tadpole" is an early life stage of a tunicate.
Tunicates are related to humans because they
have a notochord, although it disappears as the
larva matures. Sea squirts, found in the invertebrate lab, are adult tunicates.
