Mapping irrigated areas in the Limpopo Province, South Africa Cai, Xueliang, Magidi, J., Nhamo, Luxon, van Koppen, Barbara, 2017-06-05 This report summarizes the findings of a collaborative effort to map and assess irrigated areas in the Limpopo Province South Africa The study was conducted by the International Water Management Institute IWMI in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture Forestry and Fisheries DAFF and the Limpopo Department of Agriculture and Rural Development LDARD as part of the DAFF supported Revitalization of irrigation in South Africa project Based on a combination of Landsat and Moderate Resolution Imaging Spectroradiometer MODIS satellite data previous irrigated area mapping exercises carried out by DAFF and three field ground truthing GT surveys a total of 1 6 million hectares Mha of cropland were identified with 262 000 ha actually irrigated in the 2015 winter season The study also found that only 29% of all land equipped with center pivots was actually irrigated
