




CAUSES OF INTERMITTENT EXPLOSIVE DISORDER (IED)

- **Genetic Factors:** IED has a hereditary component, with a higher likelihood of occurrence in individuals with a first-degree relative diagnosed with the disorder. Genetic predispositions influence traits like aggression and impulsivity, though no specific gene has been definitively linked.
- **Biological Factors:** Neurotransmitter imbalances, particularly serotonin, and structural abnormalities in brain regions controlling impulse regulation, such as the orbitofrontal cortex and amygdala, contribute to IED. Studies using MRI scans confirm reduced gray matter in these areas, affecting aggression control.
- **Environmental Factors:** Adverse childhood experiences, such as exposure to violence, abuse, or harsh discipline, increase the risk of IED. These early experiences shape aggressive response patterns, especially when children witness or endure hostility.

IED arises from a combination of genetic, biological, and environmental factors, emphasizing the need for comprehensive approaches to prevention and treatment.
