other followers of Copernicus for their beliefs about the universe that many worlds exist and that the Earth moves because it has a soul Challenging the accepted history of astronomy to reveal Bruno as a true innovator whose contributions to the science predate those of Galileo this book shows that it was cosmology not theology that led Bruno to his death
