Wilderness is not something that exists independently from humans; instead, it exists concerning humans (Peterson 2022). This view of wilderness challenges the traditional understanding of nature as separate from and opposed to human society.

Another illustration is how Europeans viewed nature when they first arrived in North America. According to Cronon, they saw the land as an untamed wilderness that needed to be tamed and domesticated (Peterson 2022). To do this, they brought over plants and animals from Europe that they were familiar with. They also started clearing land for farming and ranching that expanded their cultivation activities. This attitude of domination continued as the United States expanded westward (Cutler 2018). As the frontier disappeared and the country became more settled, some people started to see nature in a different light. They began to appreciate the beauty of the wilderness and the peace it could bring. This led to the development of the national parks system. People began to see nature as something to be preserved, not conquered (Peterson 2022). Cronon argues that the way people view nature is constantly changing (Peterson 2022).
