Mora, Havidán Rodriguez, 2021-09-30 With its 155 mile per hour sustained windspeeds the near Category 5 Hurricane Maria brought catastrophic devastation and destruction as it diagonally crossed the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico from the southeast to the northwest on September 20 2017 The official death toll estimate of 2 975 lost lives means this record storm became one of the most devasting hurricanes not only for Puerto Rico but for the U S Many of these deaths as well as the prolonged human suffering were attributed to what was described as inadequate disaster response and slow restoration of basic services including running water electricity and the provision and distribution of food and medicine and not to the direct impact of the hurricane itself At the same time Hurricane Maria made landfall when Puerto Rico had been confronting a severe economic crisis surging for over a decade This crisis referred to as La Crisis Boricua was characterized by a significant loss of industry and jobs a deteriorating infrastructure record net outmigration a shrinking and rapidly aging
