Manning, 2025-06-12 When Hurricane Katrina struck in 2005 causing more than 1 800 deaths and more than 100 billion in damages it was deemed a once in a lifetime storm After the hurricane over 15 million volunteers came to New Orleans through various nonprofit organizations and around 500 new charities were established to aid the city's recovery We Came to Rebuild New Orleans documents this significant movement through interviews with the activists who spearheaded the city's recovery Despite widespread acknowledgment of the crucial role of nonprofit organizations in New Orleans s recovery scholarly examinations of these recovery workers experiences remain scarce We Came to Rebuild New Orleans fills this gap drawing on a vast corpus of interviews with more than fifty leaders and staff
