

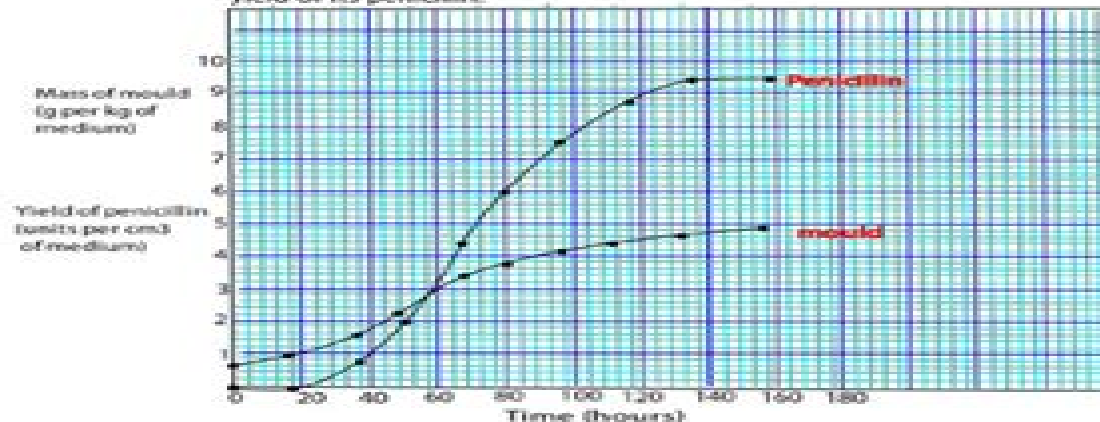

1. Growth of two micro-organism in a culture media and yield of their products was analyzed. The table below shows the growth of the yeast *saccharomyces* and the yield of its product ethanol.

Time (hours)	Mass of yeast (g per dm ³ of medium)	Yield of ethanol (g per 100cm ³ of medium)
0	1	0.2
2	1.4	0.4
4	2.4	0.6
6	4.2	1.3
8	5.9	2.5
10	6.2	2.8
12	6.1	2.6
14	5.8	2.2
