Coyotes are found living in fields, plains, forests, and woodland areas in the United States, Canada, and Mexico. Coyotes are adapting to living with humans, and now live in many cities and parks.

Coyotes are often confused with wolves and even dogs, such as German shepherds. The fur of coyotes and wolves look similar in color. Coyotes and wolves both have thick, bushy tails that they hold low to the ground. A coyote has a longer, more narrow snout, or nose area, than a wolf. Plus, coyotes are smaller and weigh much less than wolves.

Coyotes are predators and scavengers. Predators hunt for their food, and scavengers eat animals that are already dead. Coyotes prefer to eat small mammals such as rabbits, squirrels, and mice, but they also eat snakes, grass, fruit, and vegetables. Because they eat both plants and animals, they are omnivores. Coyotes are active during the day, but they mainly hunt and eat at night. Coyotes make many sounds to communicate with their pack and to other coyotes in the area.
