- Create an introduction that will feature your thesis and a summary of your analysis
- Write your thesis statement that will help to guide the writing that will follow
- Give an analysis of the work behind the topic. This involves the author's style and targeted audience
- Write on the efficacy of the work and wrap it up with a brief conclusion



GENERAL TIPS

- Research broadly on the work that you are critiquing. Research its creator, as well
- Use a previous critical essay example as a road-map when creating yours
- Infuse exciting facts about the work and ensure your opinion doesn't influence your analysis
- Double-check your work for reasons of rectifying mistakes and polishing its content
