Dream Town Laura Meckler, 2023-08-22 Winner of the Ohio Book Award Finalist of the Malott Prize for Recording Community Activism Can a group of well intentioned people fulfill the promise of racial integration in America In this searing and intimate examination of the ideals and realities of racial integration award winning Washington Post journalist Laura Meckler tells the story of a decades long pursuit in Shaker Heights Ohio and uncovers the roadblocks that have threatened progress time and again in housing in education and in the promise of shared community In the late 1950s Shaker Heights began groundbreaking work that would make it a national model for housing integration And beginning in the seventies it was known as a crown jewel in the national move to racially integrate schools The school district built a reputation for academic excellence and diversity serving as a model for how white and Black Americans can thrive together Meckler herself a product of Shaker Heights takes a deeper look into the place that shaped her investigating its complicated history and its ongoing challenges in order to untangle myth from truth She confronts an enduring and troubling question if Shaker Heights has worked so hard at racial equity why does a racial academic achievement gap persist In telling the stories of the Shakerites who have built and lived in this community Meckler asks What will it take to fulfill the promise of racial integration in America What compromises are people of all races willing to make What does success look like and has Shaker achieved it The result is a complex and masterfully reported portrait of a place that while never perfect has achieved more than most and a road map for communities that seek to do the same Includes black and white images

People's Force Robert Haldane,2018-02-26 Since its formation in 1853 the story of the Victoria Police has been interwoven with Victorian social and political history Following the amalgamation of seven separate and distinct police agencies in the colony the resultant unified body was the first of its kind in Australia Many events have shaped its development the gold rushes the Clunes riot the Kelly outbreak the maritime strikes the coming of the motor car the police strike both world wars and the Vietnam war protests the gangland wars Black Saturday bushfires and the use of DNA to solve crimes all formed part of this mosaic This revised edition of The People s Force containing a new chapter and new illustrations brings the history up to date to include a decade that has been full of turbulent change The new chapter examines the administrations of Neil Comrie Christine Nixon Simon Overland Ken Lay and Graham Ashton New material deals with Silk and Miller and other police shootings the growth of terrorism gender issues racism and domestic violence Written as awarts and all history of the Victoria Police with the support and encouragement of the then Chief Commissioner S I Mick Miller who wanted a proper objective history of the force not a public relations exercise This third edition is owed largely to Miller s encouragement and his desire to see the history updated

Secrecy in the Sunshine Era Jason Ross Arnold,2014-08-25 A series of laws passed in the 1970s promised the nation unprecedented transparency in government a veritable sunshine era Though citizens enjoyed a new arsenal of secrecy busting tools officials developed a handy set of workarounds from over classification to concealment shredding and burning It is this dark side of the sunshine era that Jason Ross Arnold explores in the first comprehensive comparative history of presidential resistance to the new legal regime from Reagan Bush to the first term of Obama Biden After examining what makes a necessary and unnecessary secret Arnold considers the causes of excessive secrecy and why we observe variation across administrations While some administrations deserve the scorn of critics for exceptional secrecy the book shows excessive secrecy was a persistent problem well before 9 11 during Democratic and Republican administrations alike Regardless of party administrations have consistently worked to weaken the system s legal foundations The book reveals episode after episode of evasive maneuvers rule bending clever rhetorical gambits and downright defiance an army of secrecy workers in a dizzying array of institutions labels all manner of documents top secret while other government workers and agencies manage to suppress information with a sensitive but unclassified designation For example the health effects of Agent Orange and antibiotic resistant bacteria leaking out of Midwestern hog farms are considered too sensitive for public consumption These examples and many more document how vast the secrecy system has grown during the sunshine era Rife with stories of vital scientific evidence withheld justice eluded legalities circumvented and the public interest flouted *Secrecy in the Sunshine Era* reveals how our information society has been kept in the dark in too many ways and for too long

The Schenley Experiment Jake Oresick,2017-04-14

The Schenley Experiment is the story of Pittsburgh's first public high school a social incubator in a largely segregated city that was highly even improbably successful throughout its 156 year existence Established in 1855 as Central High School and reorganized in 1916 Schenley High School was a model of innovative public education and an ongoing experiment in diversity Its graduates include Andy Warhol actor Bill Nunn and jazz virtuoso Earl Hines and its prestigious academic program and pensions lured such teachers as future Pulitzer Prize winner Willa Cather The subject of investment as well as destructive neglect the school reflects the history of the city of Pittsburgh and provides a study in both the best and worst of urban public education practices there and across the Rust Belt Integrated decades before Brown v Board of Education Schenley succumbed to default segregation during the white flight of the 1970s it rose again to prominence in the late 1980s when parents camped out in six day long lines to enroll their children in visionary superintendent Richard C Wallace's reinvigorated school Although the historic triangular building was a cornerstone of its North Oakland neighborhood and a showpiece for the city of Pittsburgh officials closed the school in 2008 citing over 50 million in necessary renovations a controversial event that captured national attention Schenley alumnus Jake Oresick tells this story through interviews historical documents and hundreds of first person accounts drawn from a community indelibly tied to the school A memorable important work of local and educational history his book is a case study of desegregation magnet education and the changing nature and legacies of America's oldest public schools **What About Us?** Diane Kerr, Tracey A.
