## Language and Definitions

### Language Functions

Language is used to express our thought. Sometimes we use term or word to express several concepts or ideas.

#### I. Language has three major functions:

1. Informative function: Language used to communicate information, to affirm or deny propositions, or to present arguments.

- Example: February 16 is holiday.

2. Expressive function: intends only to vent some feeling, or to evoke some feeling from other people.

- Example: Friday afternoons are boring.

3. Directive function: aim to cause or to prevent some overt action

- Example: Close the door.

#### Less common functions:

4. Ceremonial function (also ritual language use): mixture of Expressive and Directive function.

- Example: When we say, "How do you do?" upon being introduced to a stranger.  
Wedding invitation

5. Performative language: language which performs the action it reports

- Example: When we say, "I apologize for my foolish remark", "I congratulate you, . . ." "I accept your offer, . . ."

#### II. Forms of Language (types of sentences):

Sentence Type	Informative	Expressive	Directive
assertion / <i>declarative</i>	The room is cool.	I had a nice time.	I would like some coffee.
question / <i>interrogative</i>	Isn't this room 706?	Isn't that great?	Do you want to help me?
command / <i>imperative</i>	Read pages 1-10 for the test.	Have a nice day.	Close the windows.
exclamation / <i>exclamatory</i>	The universe is bounded!	I'm really glad!	It's late!

*In summary, the principal uses of language are three: informative, expressive, and directive. The grammatical forms of language are essentially four: declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory.*
