- Be confident in your potential results. This will improve the credibility of your paper and make readers more apt to identify with your research and approve your proposal.
- Have a third-party review and edit your proposal.

Grab the reader's attention with a fact, question, quote, analogy or short, interesting narrative supporting the thesis. This should set the tone for your paper while triggering the reader's interest
