An effective report is:

- · Appropriate to its purpose and audience
- Accurate
- Logical
- Clear and concise
- Well organised with clear section headings.

Report structure

One important advantage that a report has over other written communication is that it follows a standardised format. This enables readers to find and focus on specific parts of information. Most reports are modelled on the following structure (modified where necessary).

- 1. Transmittal document
- 2. Title page
- 3. Table of contents
- 4. Abstract/Executive Summary
- 5. Introduction
- Discussion
- 7. Conclusions
- 8. Recommendations
- Bibliography.
