Here, you'll articulate how your distinctive background and experiences equip you to make meaningful contributions to your future community.



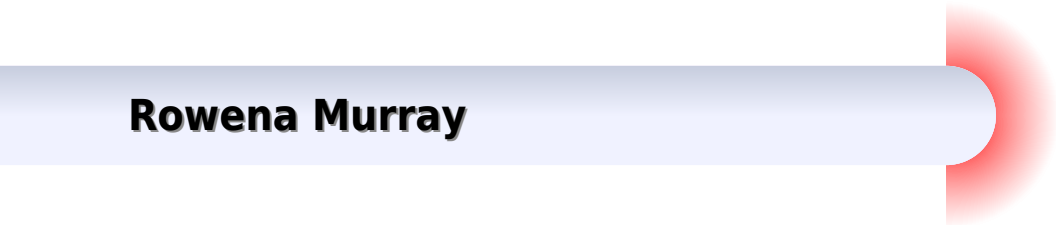
