Apocrine glands - ANSCoiled structures attached to hair follicles found in the underarm and genital areas that secrete sweat.

Arrector pili muscle - ANSThe small, involuntary muscle in the base of the hair follicle that causes goose bumps when the appendage contracts; sometimes called paoillae.

Barrier function - ANSProtective barrier of the epidermis; the corneum and intercellular matrix protect the surface from irritation and dehydration.

Bilayers - ANSA thin polar membrane made of two layers of lipid molecules; these membranes are flat sheets that form a continuous barrier around all cells.

Ceramides - ANSGlycolipid materials that are a natural part of skin's intercellular matrix and barrier function.

Collagen - ANSFibrous, connective tissue made from protein; found in the reticular layer of the dermis; gives skin its fimmess. Topically, a large, long-chain molecular protein that lies on the top of the skin and binds water, derived from the placentas of cows or other sources.

Couperose - ANSRedness; capillaries that have been damaged and are now larger, or distended, blood vessels; Commonly seen with telangiectasia.

Comeocytes - ANSAnother name for a stratum comeum cell. Hardened, waterproof, protective keratinocytes; these "dead" protein cells are dried out and lack nuclei.

Dermal Papillae - ANSMembranes of ridges and grooves that attach to the epidermis; contains nerve endings and supplies nourishment through capillaries to skin and follicles.

Dermis - ANSAlso known as derma, corium, cutis, or true skin; support layer of connective tissue, collagen, and elastin below the epidermis.

Desmosomes - ANSThe structures that assist in holding cells together; intercellular connections made of proteins.

Eccrine Glands - ANSSweat glands found all over the body with openings on the skin's surface through pores; not attached to hair follicles, secretions do not produce an offensive odor.
