- C. In France and in most other countries where the metric system of measurements is used, a comma is used to indicate a decimal while a period is used to indicate thousands, millions, etc. \$3,478.56 (instead of \$3,478.56)

- a. Unlike English, which stresses the pronunciation of a specific syllable within a word, French syllables are evenly stressed. The last syllable of a word, however, is slightly emphasized.
- b. Diacritical marks consist of three kinds of accents: acute, grave, and circumflex, the cedilla and the tréma.
1. The acute sign is used to open up the sound of a vowel *e* when it is not followed by a final *d, f* or *n*: *été*, *regarde*, *été*.
2. The grave sign is used
a. on an open *e* at the end of a syllable or before a final *r*: *été*, *été*.
- b. on a difference (no homonym) (words spelled alike but which have a different meaning): *un* (*where*) and *un* (*not*), *le* (*in*, *at*) and *lé* (*above*), *le* (*the*) and *l'é* (*the*).
- c. on the vowel *e* in words such as *été*, *été*, *été*, *été*, *été* (as in *été*).
3. The circumflex sign is used on any of the vowels
a. to indicate that a formerly used vowel or an *e* has been dropped: *été* (*where*), *été* (*where*), *été* (*where*).
- b. to change the sound of certain vowels: *été*, *été*.
- c. to differentiate two homonyms: *été* (*past*), *été* (*past*), *été* (*past*) and the pronunciation of the *e*: *été*, *été* (*past*), *été* (*past*) and the pronunciation of the *e*: *été*, *été* (*past*), *été* (*past*).
4. The cedilla is used beneath the letter *c* when it precedes the vowels *e*, *e*, *e* to give it an *e* sound: *été*, *été*, *été*.
5. The tréma is placed above the vowels *e*, *e*, *e* to indicate that they are pronounced independently of any preceding or following vowel sound: *été*, *été*.

- A. When representing a date or the name of a month, only *ordinal* numerals are used. Otherwise, a *cardinal* numeral is used. In greater numbers the *ordinal* must precede the *cardinal*.
 B. An *ordinal* number is written by placing an elevated *o* next to the number: 1st, 2nd, 15th, 21st.

- A. An *-s* is added to most singular nouns to form their plural: *an flower/s*, *an letter/s*, *an chair/s*, *an chicken/s*.
- B. If the noun already ends in *-s*, *-x* or *-z*, the plural form remains the same: *an filth/s*, *an life/s*, *an analysis/s*, *an crisis/s*.
- C. Most nouns ending in *-al* change to *-als*: *a character/s*, *a comedian/s*, *a character/s*.
- D. Most nouns ending in *-us* or *-us* form their plural by adding *-i*: *an character/s*, *an character/s*.
- E. Exceptions to this rule are several words which only add *-s* to form their plural: *bad/s*, *out/s*, *curious/s*, *usual/s*, *fatal/s*, *viral/s*.
- F. Most nouns ending in *-um* or *-um* form their plural by adding *-a*: *an character/s*, *an character/s*.
- G. Exceptions: *an power/s*, *an power/s*.
- H. Most nouns ending in *-all* normally add *-s* to form their plural: *an strait/s*, *an strait/s*.
- I. Exceptions to this rule are nine nouns which change *-all* to *-als* to form their plural: *half/halfs*, *cent/hundreds*, *thousand/hundreds*, *million/millions*, *trillion/trillions*, *hundred/hundreds*, *thousand/thousands*, *million/millions*, and *trillion/trillions*.
- J. Most nouns ending in *-um* add *-a* to form their plural: *an tree/s*, *an tree/s*.
- K. Exceptions are the following seven words which add *-s* to form their plural: *hippo/hippos*, *calico/calicos*, *chico/chicos*, *grape/grapes*, *hobby/hobbies*, *jeep/jeeps*, and *tomato/tomatoes*.
- L. Some nouns have two forms for their plural forms, each form having a different meaning or usage: *child/children*, *deer/deer*.
