TO INVESTIGATE THE PROCESS OF MEIOSIS

Organisms produced by sexual reproduction are truly new organisms. They have different sets of genes from their parents. The gametes formed by meiosis are just for the purpose of sexual reproduction. Gametes cannot grow into another organism until they fuse with another gamete to form a zygote. When the zygote forms, it is genetically unique.

Genetic variation allows a species to have a better chance of adapting to and surviving sudden changes in the environment. No two individuals in a sexually reproducing population are exactly the same. Meiosis during sexual reproduction therefore ensures maximum genetic variation and improved the chances of a species' survival.

Weiss, 1999 In 1996 the National Assessment of Educational Progress NAEP assessed the knowledge and skills of students in the areas of earth science life science and physical science It also collected information related to the background of students grades 4 8 and 12 their teachers grades 4 and 8 and the schools they attended grades 4 8 and 12 This report is intended primarily for science teachers hence the results presented relate directly to student performance classroom practices and school climate This report also discusses students attitudes and beliefs about science The report is divided into four parts In the first part chapter 1 an overview of the assessment is provided This includes information about the framework used in the development of the assessment a description of how the assessment was administered to students and an explanation of how to interpret NAEP results In the second part chapters 2 3 and 4 examples of questions and student responses are presented These chapters are divided by grade The third part chapters 5 and 6 contains information collected from students teachers and school administrators about classroom practices student motivation and parental involvement in learning Finally the fourth part contains appendices offering a fuller description of the procedures used for the NAEP 1996 science assessment appendix A scoring guides for questions discussed in chapters 2 3 and 4 appendix B and standard errors for the statistics presented in the report appendix C WRM

Academically Adrift Richard Arum, Josipa Roksa, 2011-01-15 In spite of soaring tuition costs more and more students go to college every year A bachelor s degree is now required for entry into a growing number of professions And some parents begin planning for the expense of sending their kids to college when they re born Almost everyone strives to go but almost no one asks the fundamental question posed by Academically Adrift are undergraduates really learning anything once they get there For a large proportion of students Richard Arum and Josipa Roksa s answer to that question is a definitive no Their extensive research draws on survey responses transcript data and for the first time the state of the art Collegiate Learning Assessment a standardized test administered to students in their first semester and then again at the end of their second year According to their analysis of more than 2 300 undergraduates at twenty four institutions 45 percent of these students demonstrate no significant improvement in a range of skills including critical thinking complex reasoning and writing during their first two years of college As troubling as their findings are Arum and Roksa argue that for many faculty and administrators they will come as no surprise instead they are the expected result of a student body distracted by socializing or working and an institutional culture that puts undergraduate learning close to the bottom of the priority list Academically Adrift holds sobering lessons for students faculty administrators policy makers and parents all of whom are implicated in promoting or at least ignoring contemporary campus culture Higher education faces crises on a number of fronts but Arum and Roksa s report that colleges are failing at their most basic mission will demand the attention of us all **The NAEP ...**
