Secondary data refers to information that has been collected by someone other than the user, typically for a purpose different from the user's current research question. It is pre-existing data that can be sourced from various publications, databases, and other studies.

EXAMPLES

- **Census Data:** Government-collected data that provides comprehensive information about the population, including demographics and employment.
- **Academic Journals:** Peer-reviewed articles and studies that contain data and findings relevant to various academic fields.
