Fault Lines of History Uma Chakravarti, 2017-01-17 The Sexual Violence and Impunity in South Asia research project coordinated by Zubaan and supported by the International Development Research Centre brings together for the first time in the region a vast body of knowledge on this important yet silenced subject Six country volumes one each on Bangladesh Nepal Pakistan Sri Lanka and two on India comprising over fifty research papers and two book length studies detail the histories of sexual violence and look at the systemic institutional societal individual and community structures that work together to perpetuate impunity for perpetrators This volume the second on India addresses the question of state impunity suggesting that on the issue of the violation of human and civil rights and particularly in relation to the question of sexual violence the state has been an active and collusive partner in creating states of exception where its own laws can be suspended and the rights of its citizens violated Drawing on patterns of sexual violence in Kashmir the Northeast of India Chhattisgarh Haryana and Rajasthan the essays together focus on the long histories of militarization and regions of conflict as well as the normalized histories of caste violence which are rendered invisible because it is convenient to pretend they do not exist Even as the writers note how heavily the odds are stacked against the victims and survivors of sexual violence they turn their attention to recent histories of popular protest that have enabled speech They stress that while this is both crucial and important it is also necessary to note the absence of sufficient attention to the range of locations where sexual violence is endemic and often ignored Resistance speech the breaking of silence the surfacing of memory these as the writers powerfully argue are the new weapons in the fight to destroy impunity and hold accountable the perpetrators of sexual violence Published by Zubaan

[The Secret History of UK Security Vetting from 1909 to the Present](#) Daniel Lomas, 2025-05-15 Using newly available government records private papers and documents obtained through Freedom of Information this book tells the secret story of UK security vetting from 1909 to the present Although Britain avoided American style red baiting and McCarthy like witch hunts successive UK governments have like their Five Eyes allies implemented security procedures to protect government defence and industry from so called subversives and fellow travellers Officially from 1948 the British

government applied political tests to civil servants a process extended to character defects in the early 1950s with the introduction of positive vetting However an unofficial purge had taken place for much longer facing political backlashes as an infringement of civil liberties and suppression of free speech Although it s been argued that Britain s secret purge had little impact this study looks at the experiences of those removed from the secret state those LGBT and BAME individuals discriminated against by government and the impact of government policy generally while studying the responses of Ministers and civil servants to spy scandals and international events Drawing from newly released archival material Freedom of Information releases and interviews this book offers new insights into the scope of government security checks on civil servants defence contractors and armed forces personnel from Edwardian spy scares and the inter war period to the Cold War and present day

The Struggle Is Eternal Joseph R. Fitzgerald, 2018-12-14 Many prominent and well known figures greatly impacted the civil rights movement but one of the most influential and unsung leaders of that period was Gloria Richardson As the leader of the Cambridge Nonviolent Action Committee CNAC a multifaceted liberation campaign formed to target segregation and racial inequality in Cambridge Maryland Richardson advocated for economic justice and tactics beyond nonviolent demonstrations Her philosophies and strategies including her belief that black people had a right to self defense were adopted often without credit by a number of civil rights and black power leaders and activists *The Struggle Is Eternal* Gloria Richardson and Black Liberation explores the largely forgotten but deeply significant life of this central figure and her determination to improve the lives of black people Using a wide range of source materials including interviews with Richardson and her personal papers as well as interviews with dozens of her friends relatives and civil rights colleagues Joseph R Fitzgerald presents an all encompassing narrative From Richardson s childhood when her parents taught her the importance of racial pride through the next eight decades Fitzgerald relates a detailed and compelling story of her life He reveals how Richardson s human rights activism extended far beyond Cambridge and how her leadership style and vision for liberation were embraced by the younger activists of the black power movement who would carry the struggle on throughout the late 1960s and into the 1970s
