

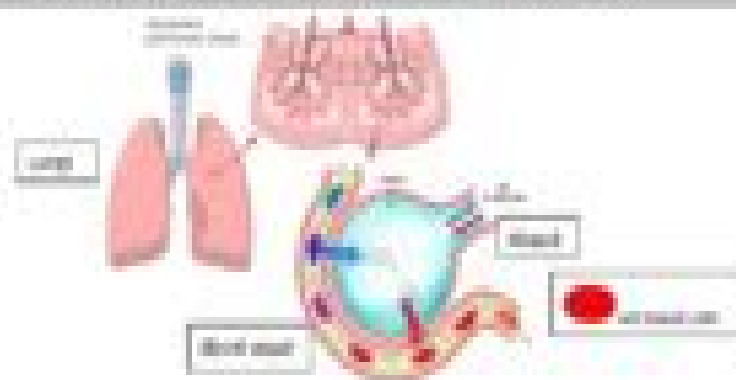

Human Body System Interaction Review

Why? There are many organ systems in the body, each with a specific function. However, they do not work alone. The organ systems in the human body interact to perform the necessary functions for life. Through interactions, the body systems maintain internal balance or equilibrium known as homeostasis.

Model 1: Respiratory and Circulatory

The **respiratory system** is responsible for gas exchange. It includes the lungs (O₂ goes into the body and CO₂ leaves the body) and the **circulatory system**, however, does not work alone. It relies on the **circulatory system** to transport the gases around the body. This exchange of gas is not from the blood stream of the circulatory system, takes place in the alveoli, tiny air sacs in the lung. This exchange maintains the correct concentrations of gases within the blood to maintain homeostasis: respiration.



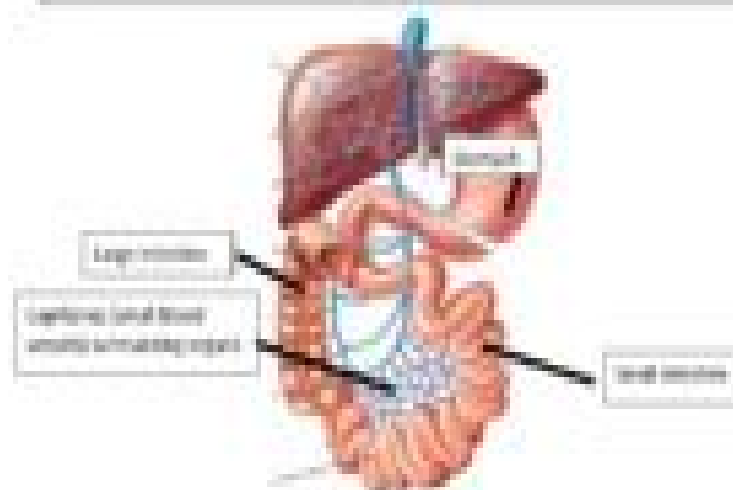

Model 2: Digestive and Circulatory

The **digestive system** breaks down food into essential nutrients for the body to use. But how do these nutrients get to the cells? After food is broken down by chemical and mechanical digestion in the mouth, stomach and small intestine, absorption takes place. Nutrients are absorbed (taken up) from the small intestine into the blood stream of the circulatory system. The circulatory system transports the nutrients around the body for
