
# **HUMAN EVOLUTION: NOTES**

#### THE PLACE OF HUMANS IN THE ANIMAL KINGDOM

- Humans are mammals, belonging to the class Mammalia, because their bodies are covered in hair and they suckle their young. All mammals also have three ossicles (bones) in the middle ear.
- Humans are classified in the class Mammalia, order Primates. Primates. include humans, ages, orangutans, gorifas and chimpanzees.
- The order Primates includes the superfamily Hominoidea that is subdivided. into two families, i.e. Hominidae (Great Apes and humans) and Hylobatidae (albborn).
- Family Hominidae is divided into two subtanties, i.e. Ponginae and Herminimum.
- Some scientists divide the subfamily Homininae into two more tribes. Lo. Hominini and Corillini
- . Humans, corillas and chimpenzees fall under the subfamily Mgesininae and the orangutaris are part of Ponginae.
- . Humans belong to the genus Moreo.



All members of the family Hominidae are known as hominide (Great Apes and humans). However, certain sources refer to hominids as only humans and their fossil ancestors (the Great Apes excluded). A new term, hominins, is currently used by scientists, which refers to humans and their fossil ancestors.

MB: In this study quide we will use the term bominin for bipedal humans and their fossil ancestors. The term homistid will be used when reference is made to the Great Apex as well as humans and their fossil ancestors. Great Apes, are also often referred to an African Apes.






