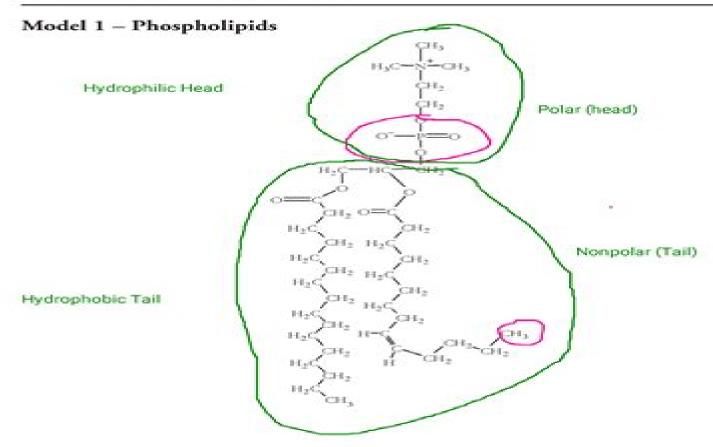

A plasma membrane compartmentalizes internal structures while the cell membrane acts as a boundary between the cell and the external environment.
